All you send for baby is the formula and nappies for the day as well as 2 x bottles for baby. Fee includes tissues and wet wipes. Once baby can start on solids we supply breakfast, teatime snack, lunch, afternoon snacks as well as the communication book

Toddler / Potty Training – Full day (12-24 months)

Fee for Babies include breakfast, teatime snack, lunch, afternoon snack, tissue and wet wipes and tuck shop every Friday. You will need to send nappies daily and at least 4 x panties/underpants that stay in the class for potty training. A communication book will also be supplied.

Toddlers 3 -6 years – Full day

Fee for toddlers include breakfast, teatime snack, lunch, afternoon snack, tuck shop every Friday, Phyzzed sports once a week, tissues, and wet wipes.

Aftercare
